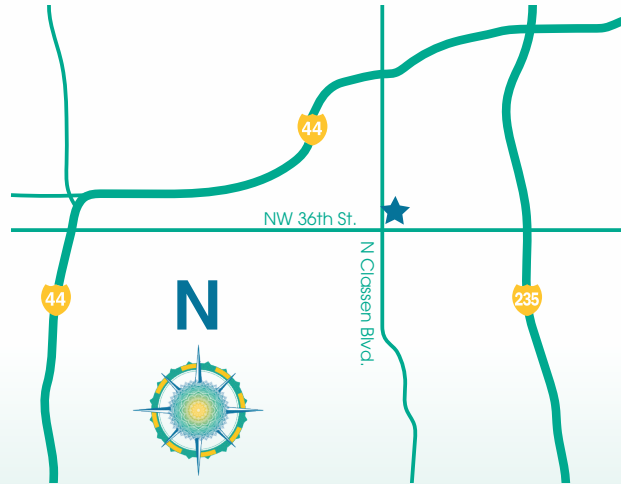




LEA MAY, MS, LMFT-S, RPT-S

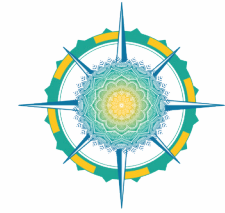
